Task Force on Business Liaison Groups**

An Update of the Progress of Business Liaison Groups

Purpose

This paper provides an update of the overall work progress of the ten Business Liaison Groups (BLGs) since the last meeting of the Task Force on Business Liaison Groups (BLGTF) held on 29 September 2022.

Progress

2. From 16 September to 16 December 2022, we have conducted four BLG meetings and proactively liaised with the trade of four BLGs. A total of ten issues were satisfactorily resolved or clarified and 15 information dissemination sessions on business facilitation measures, regulatory requirements and e-services for licence applications were conducted by the relevant departments as arranged by the Secretariat. A breakdown of these figures by the BLGs is shown at *Appendix*. BLGTF Paper 136 sets out some e-services for licence applications which benefit a large variety of trades related to the BLGs.

3. To enhance communication with the trade, the Secretariat continues the provision of various channels including an online form for the trade to share their views on licensing application and regulatory regime, and the uploading of summaries on the views collected and the Government responses onto the [Business Facilitation Initiatives website](#) on a regular basis. Salient examples are presented in the 32nd meeting of the BLGTF.

4. The Secretariat will provide advance notice to members once the schedule for future BLG meetings is available so that members can attend the BLG meetings as observers.
